

Why are we here?

Rally for Choice is a counter-demonstration to *Rally for Life*, which is a gathering of ‘pro-life’ activists in celebration of the fact that women in Ireland are still denied the right to autonomy over their own bodies. This is utter madness and we’re here to make sure that people don’t think that such an event can happen in Ireland without coming into opposition.

What do we want?

We want **free, safe and legal abortions** to be available to any woman who wishes to have one — every woman should have the right to do what she wants with her own body. We want a proper system of **sex education** and complete **access to contraception** and other services, so that less women have to resort to abortion. We want an adequate **child benefit system**, so that financial pressures are never a motivation for choosing not to have a child.
